



Summary of DARE's LEAP's support services

Prepared for final report in October 2018:

Directly to Students:

1. Testing for learning disabilities
2. Counselling
3. 30 extra DARE LEAP Support days of workshops over 2 semesters for English, Mathematics, Academic Skills, Time Management for Academic and Family Demands, etc.
4. Computer technology room for their use and for teaching courses (estimated 6 hours a day for computer courses, statistics, English, regularly and other courses periodically).
5. Computer room is for the use of LEAP students for homework and research.
6. Counselling for choosing department for regular studies
7. Meetings with The chairpersons of all of Gordons 14 departments and students of similar background in these departments.
8. Scholarship of 5,000K to each LEAP student that enters the regular program
9. Endowment scholarship fund for needy students (Negotiated authorization from foundation to extend Ethiopian Endowment scholarship to include needy students from any background).
10. Development of online and blended accessible courses (increase of 20% from 70 to over 100).

Indirectly to students via staff and faculty training.

1. Staff mentoring by Head of the preparatory program and CURE team
2. Faculty training to develop more accessible online courses
