Access to diversity


In some states more than 80% of young people go to university. In other states less than 10% benefit from a university education.




In DARE we:

- ▶ develop support programs for students with disabilities, women and ethnic minorities
- ▶ establish academic centers for ethnic minorities students and students with disabilities
- ▶ Train faculty and administrative staff to provide services that meet the needs of ethnic minorities students and students with disabilities
- ▶ develop on-line courses for the benefit
- ▶ make policy recommendations for the promotion of diversity and inclusive education in Georgia and Israel

Pedagogy of Difference is a philosophy grounded in the idea that the task of education in a liberal democracy is to prepare citizens whose beliefs, values, and ways of life are deeply different from one another to live together in peace. Every person is entitled to education in an identity to which they are heir or with which they chose to affiliate, in this view, provided that such an identity enables dialogue with others whose identities are different from one's own.
